- 1) Reminder to check the Delaware State Parks web site for equine trail information. <http://www.destateparks.com/activities/horseback/index.asp>. Beach riding season opened November 1 for Cape Henlopen and Fenwick Island State Parks. Beach riding opened Labor Day at Delaware Seashore State Park from Keybox Road parking lot.

Due to storm events, beaches are sometimes closed. It is a good to contact the parks in advance to determine if there are any closures.
